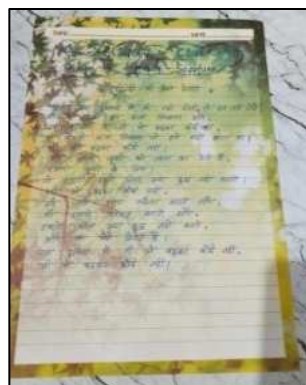
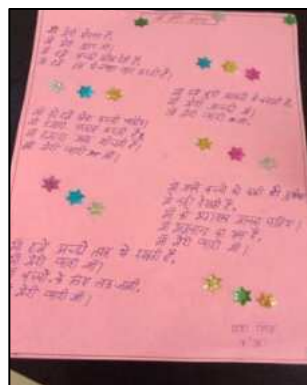
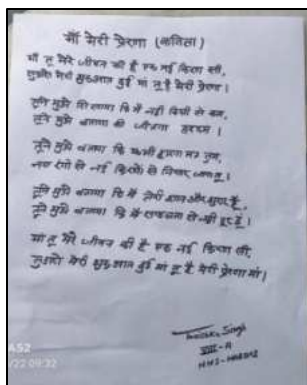
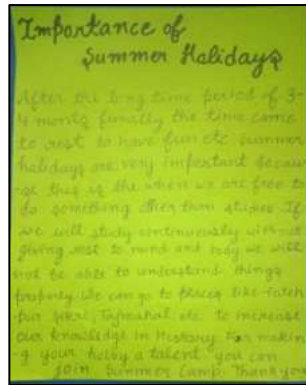
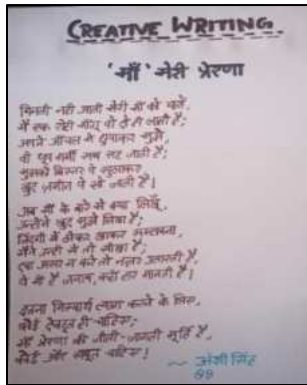
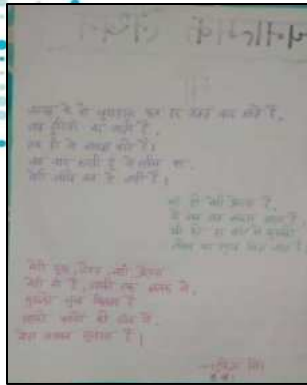
## SUNDER HARDOI WORKSHOP

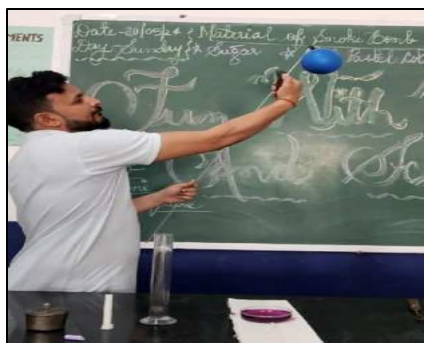
## SUMMER CAMP-2024 DRAMATICS & ELOCUTION ( STD. III<sup>rd</sup> TO IX<sup>th</sup>)

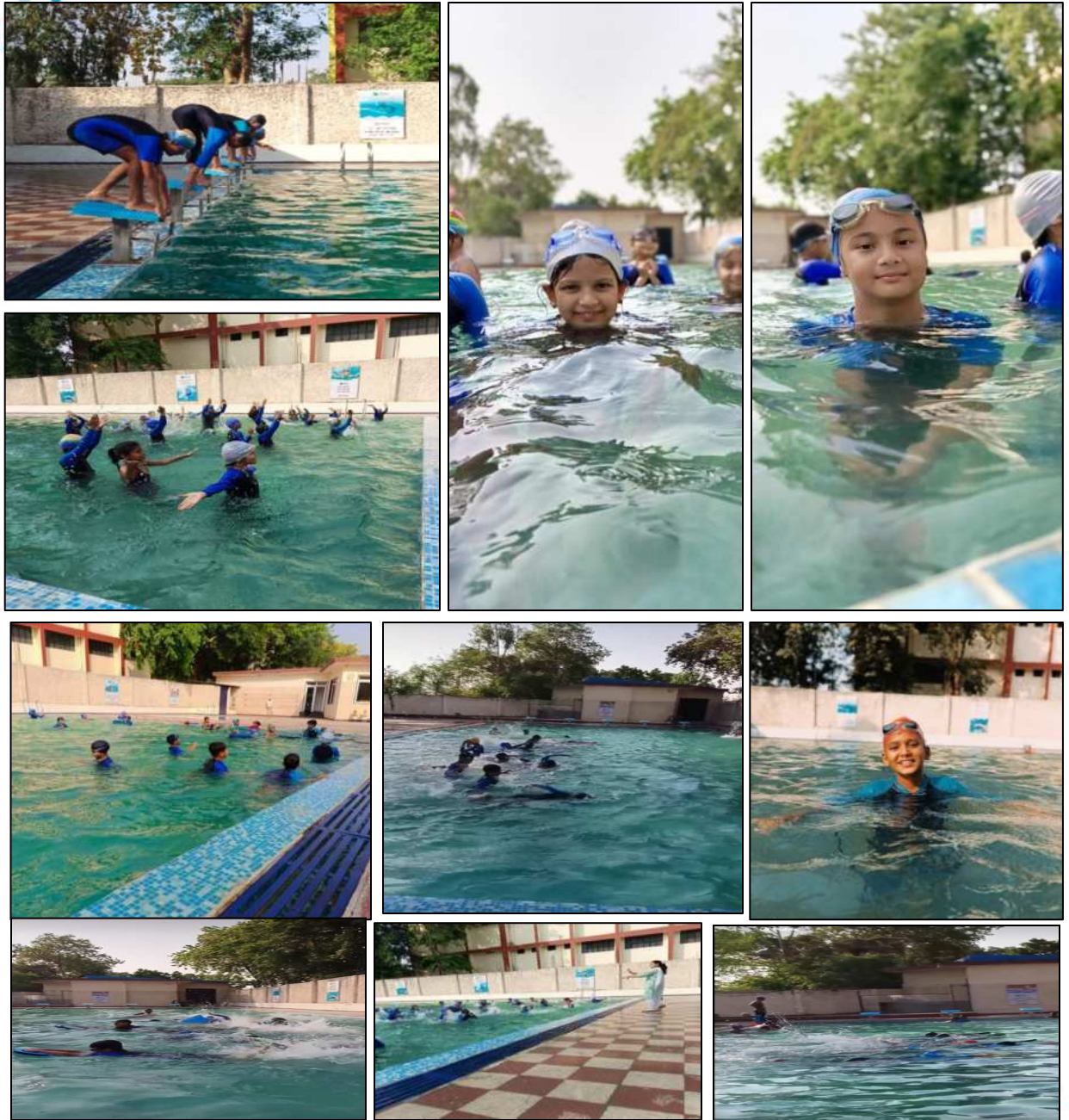
## SUMMER CAMP-2024

# SOCIAL SCIENCE SOCIETY -EXTRAVAGANZA

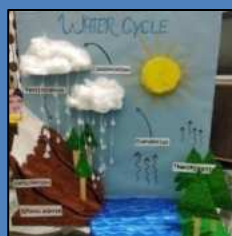

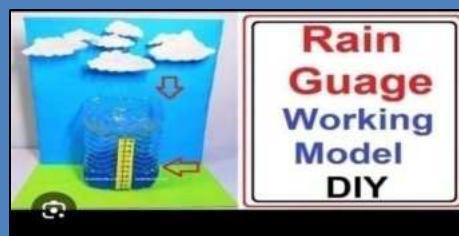
