#### SCIENCE CLUB

#### Voltak Vitlize

The NHS Science Club started on April 20, 2024, and the members of the club meet every Saturday to plan and work on the multiple projects decided by the club. The club consists of 31 students who love science and want to learn more. The club explored amniocentesis, a test that can diagnose genetic disorders during pregnancy. The club also discussed the importance of informed consent and how it affects people's attitudes towards disability. The club built Tesla Coils and watched as they created high-voltage electricity and cool plasma arcsut The members of the club also learnt about electromagnetic induction and resonance. The club also designed a model using electricity to split water into hydrogen and oxygen, a process called electrolysis. The model shows how this can be used in energy storage and fuel cells.
