VENUE: NEW HEIGHTS SCHOOL, HARDOI

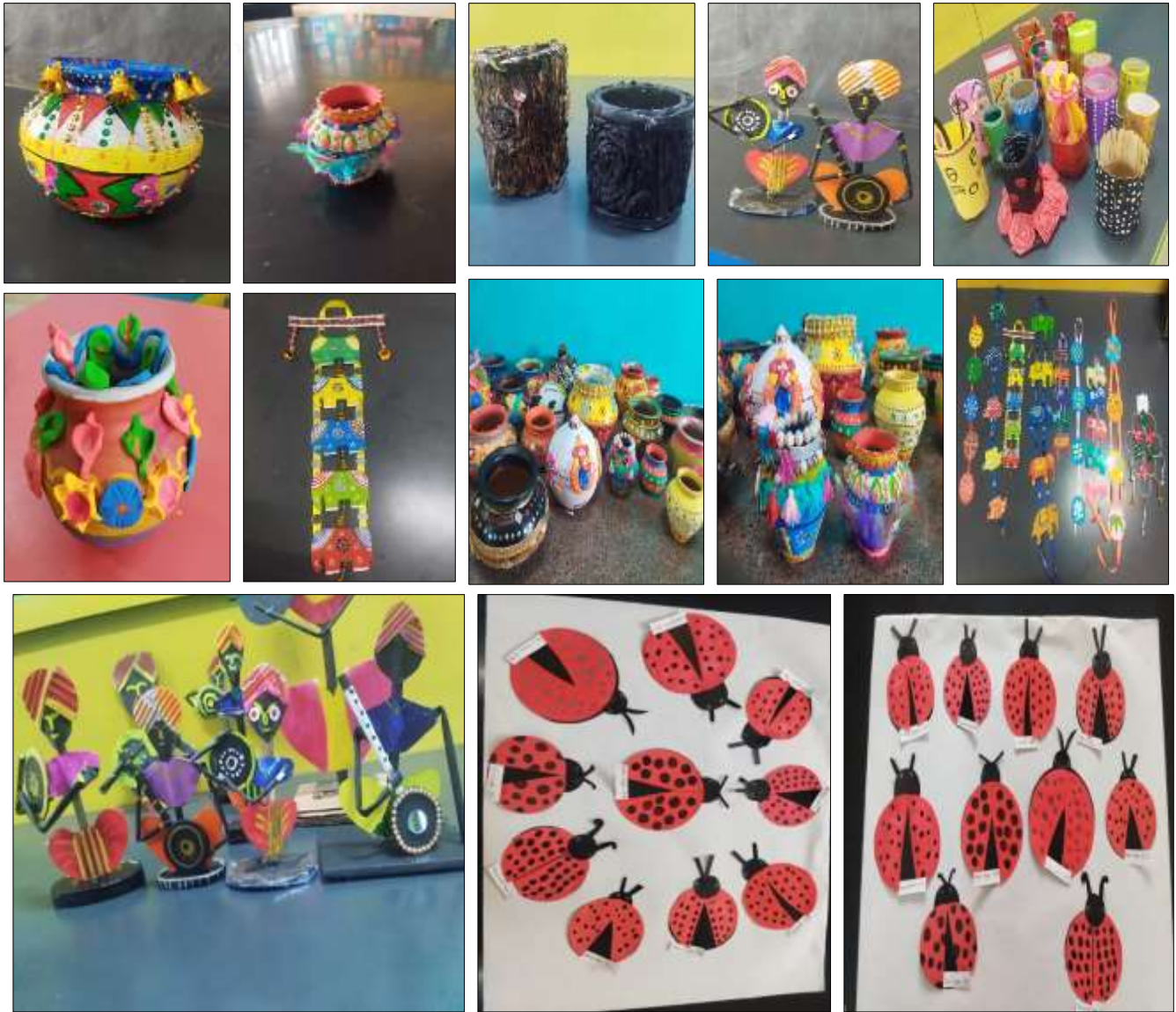
