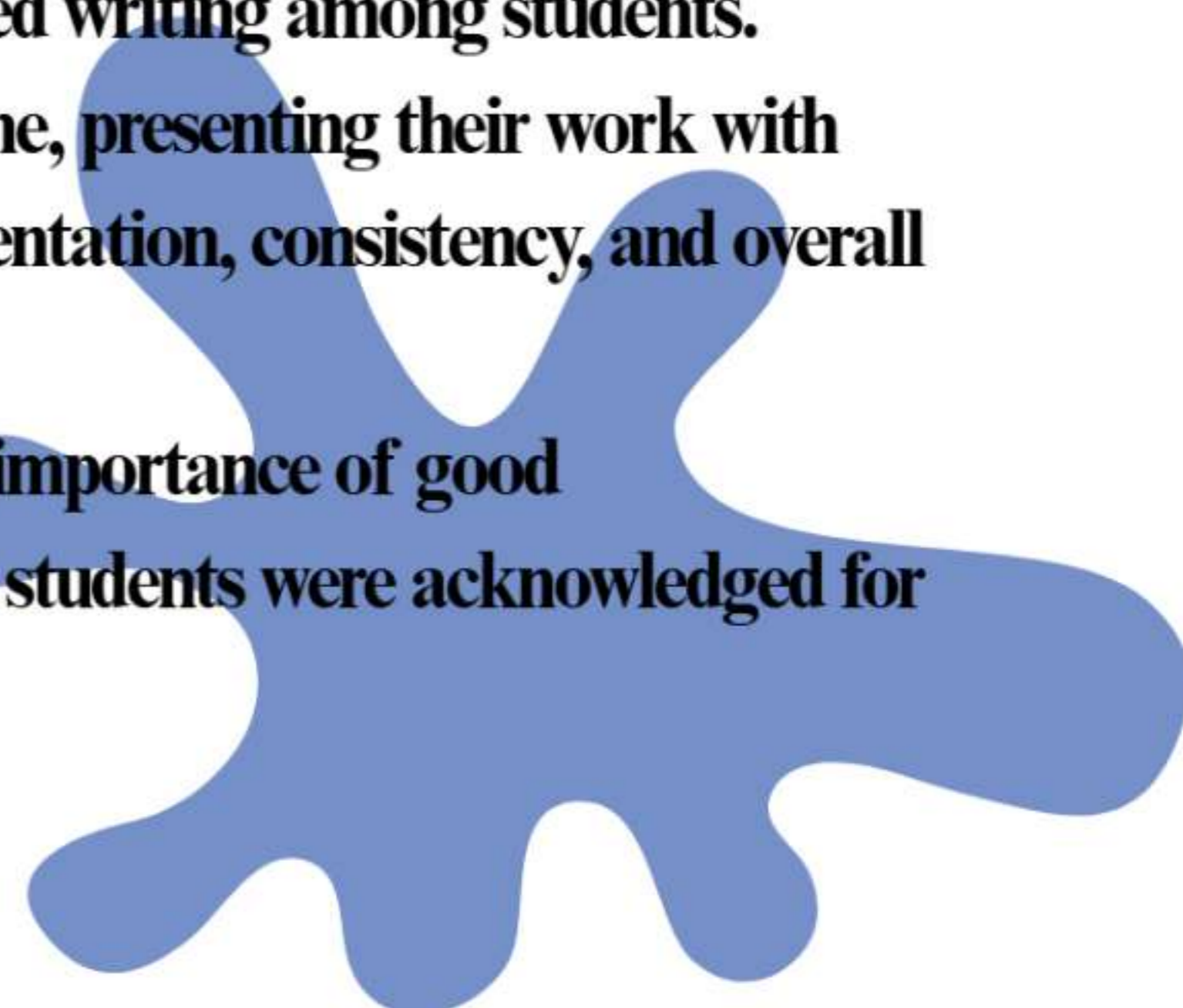
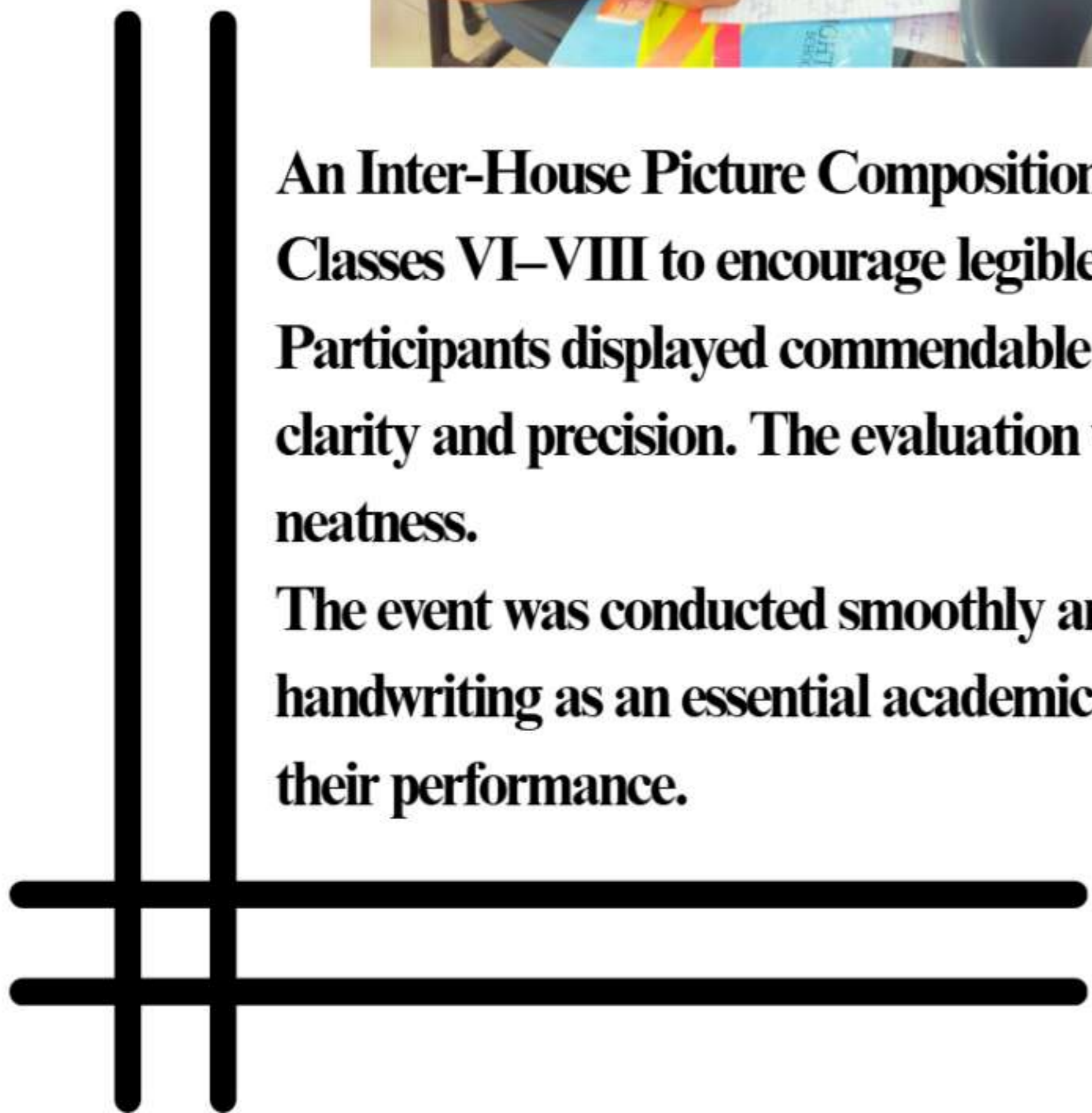


Inter-House Picture Composition (VI to VIII)

The event was conducted smoothly and highlighted the importance of good handwriting as an essential academic skill. Meritorious students were acknowledged for their performance.



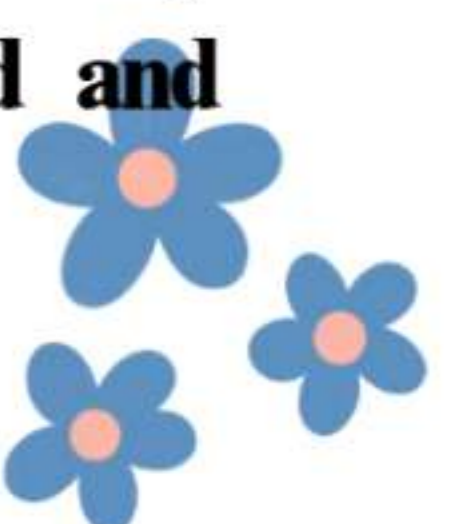
Inter-House Creative Writing (IX to XII)

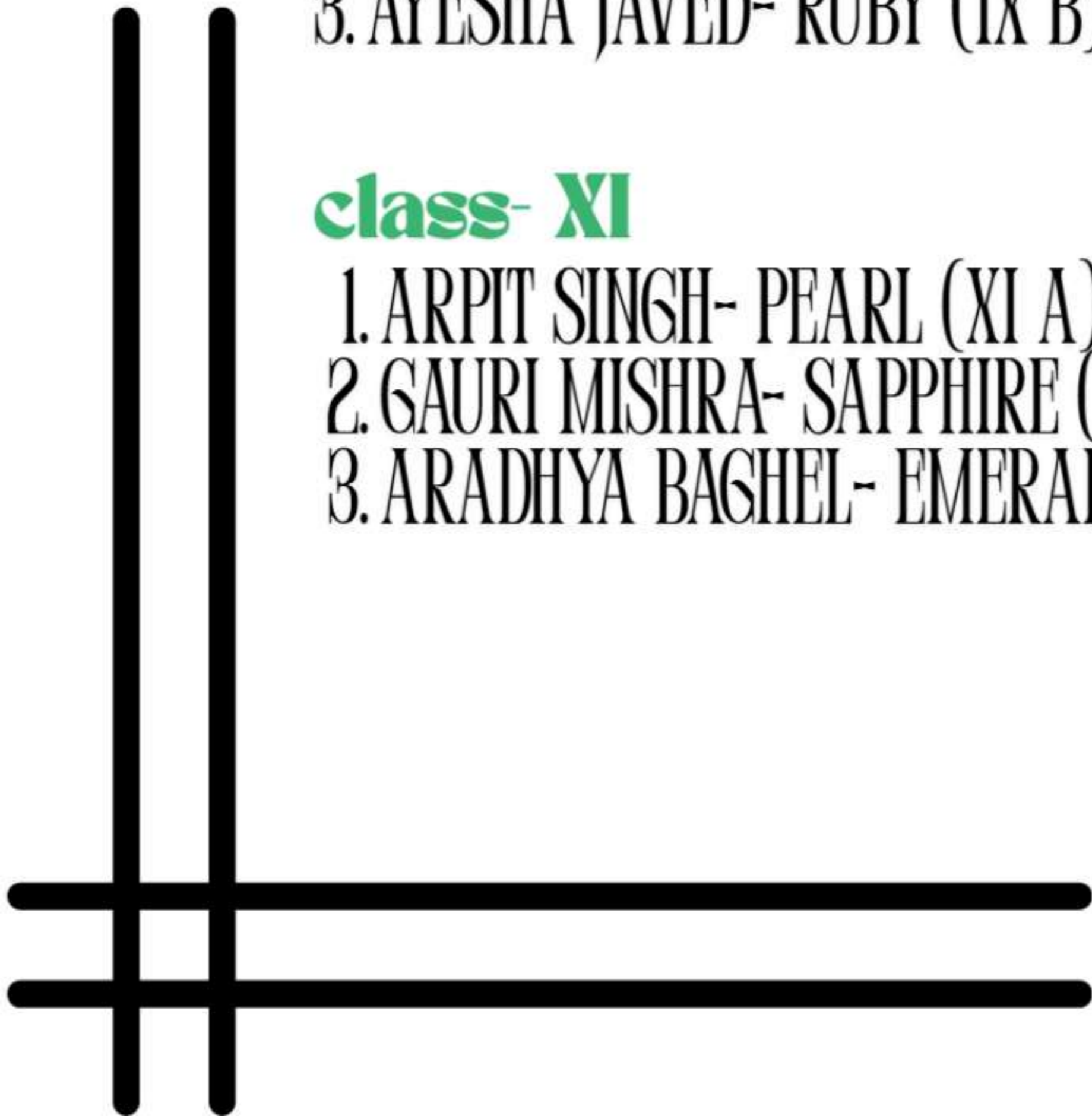

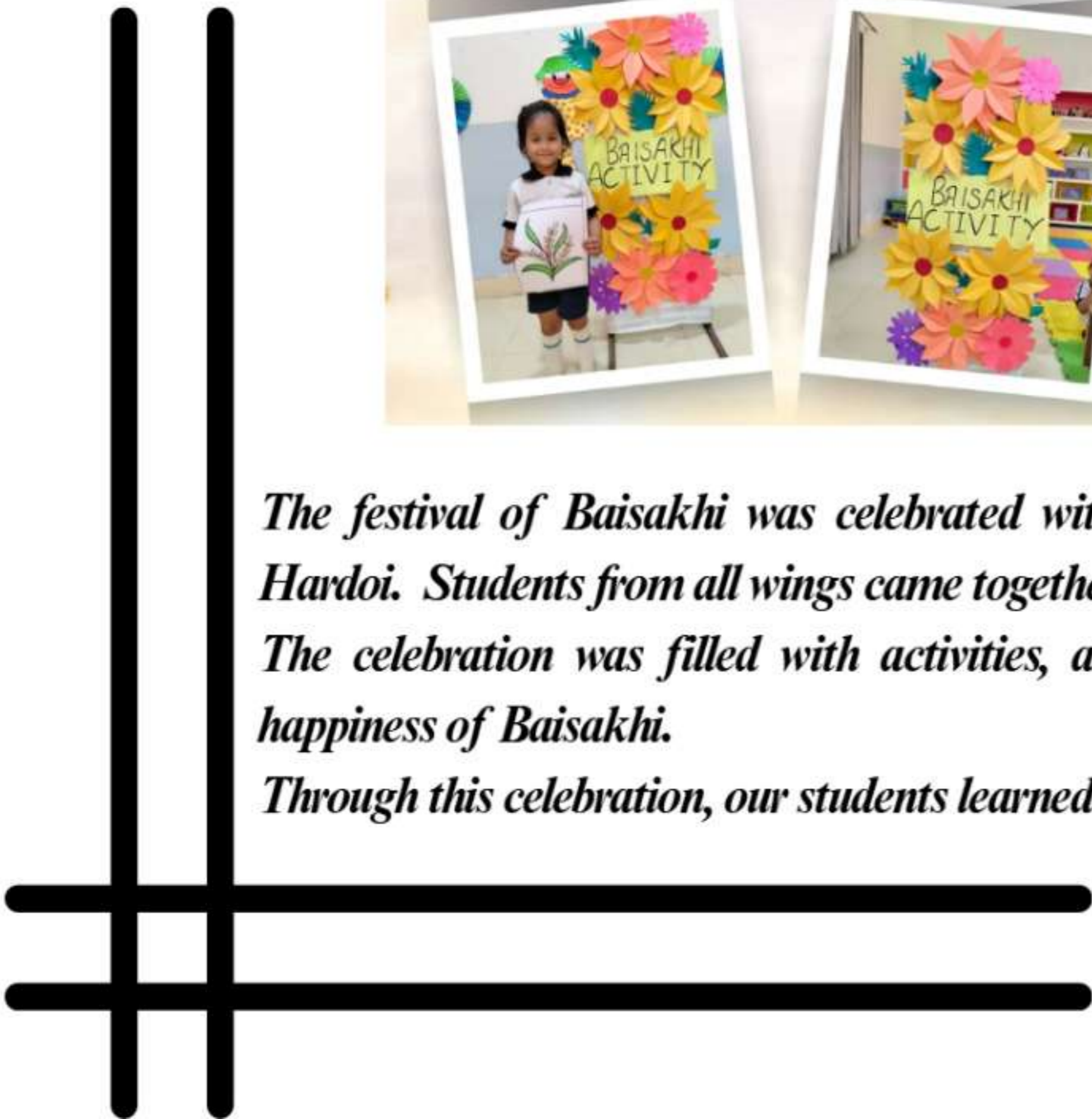

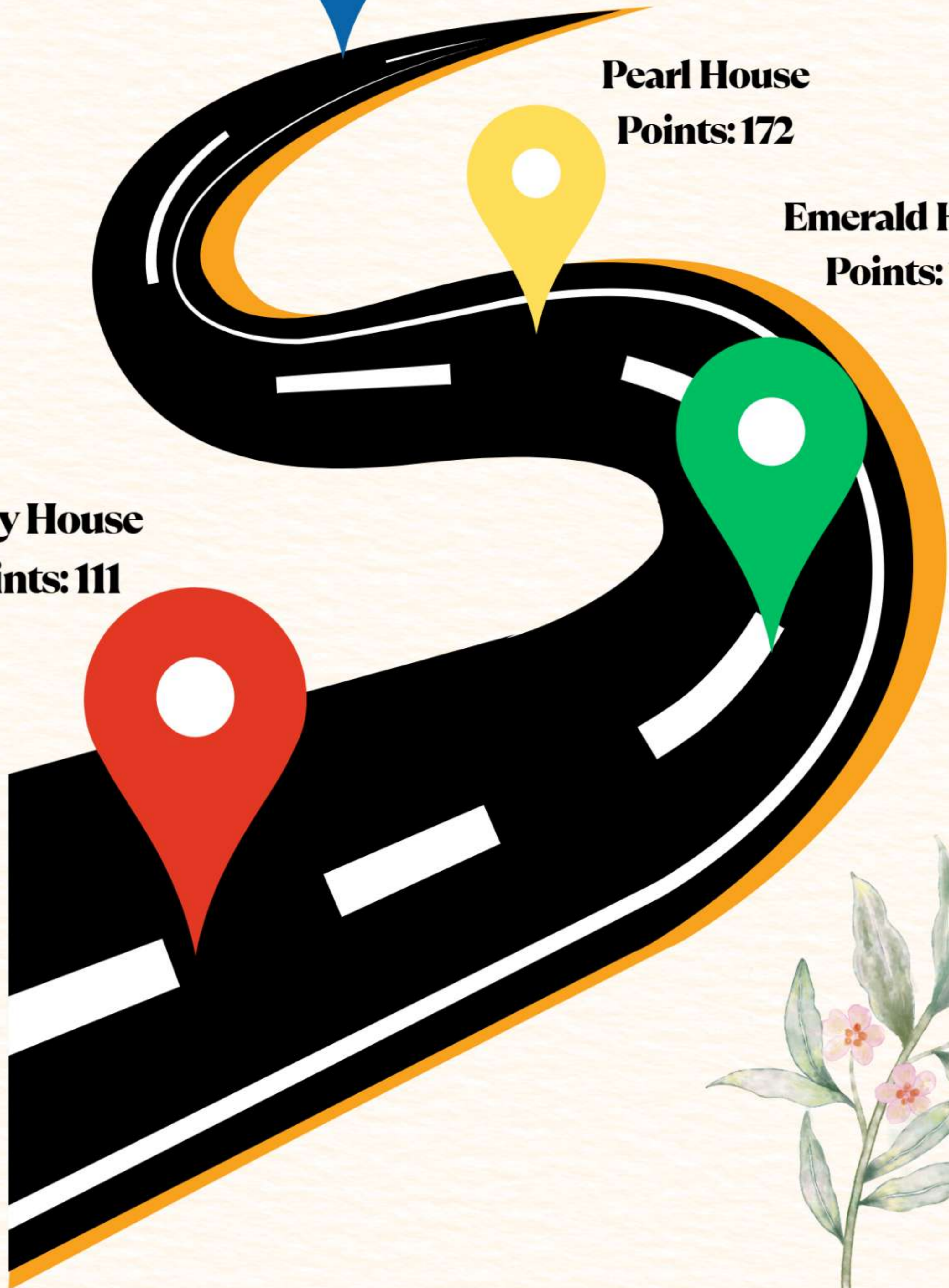
